In this activity book, you will be researching different buildings and landmarks in Weston, and looking into their past.



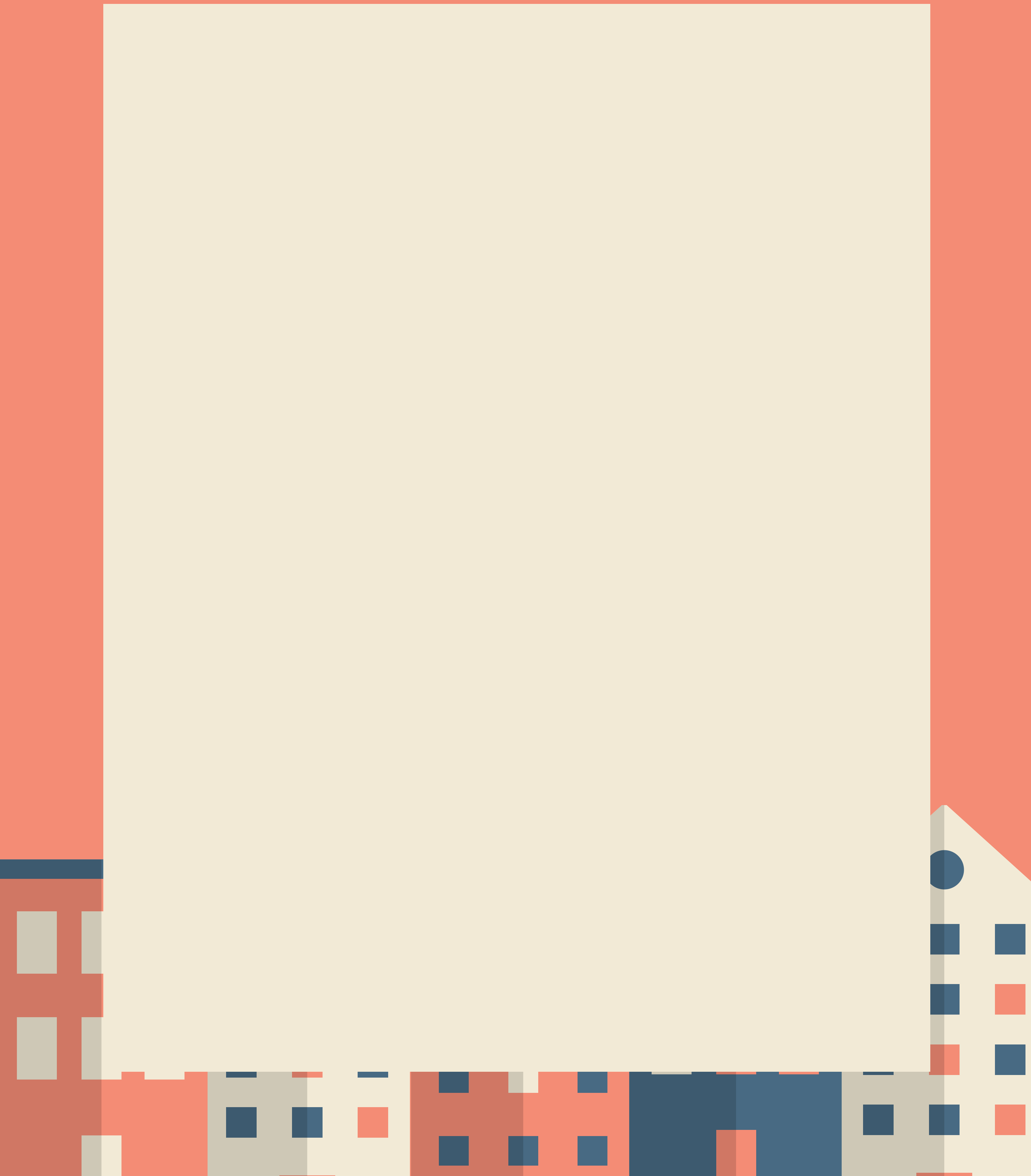
THINGS WE ARE LOOKING FOR

Throughout your research, we are looking for certain facts about each building:

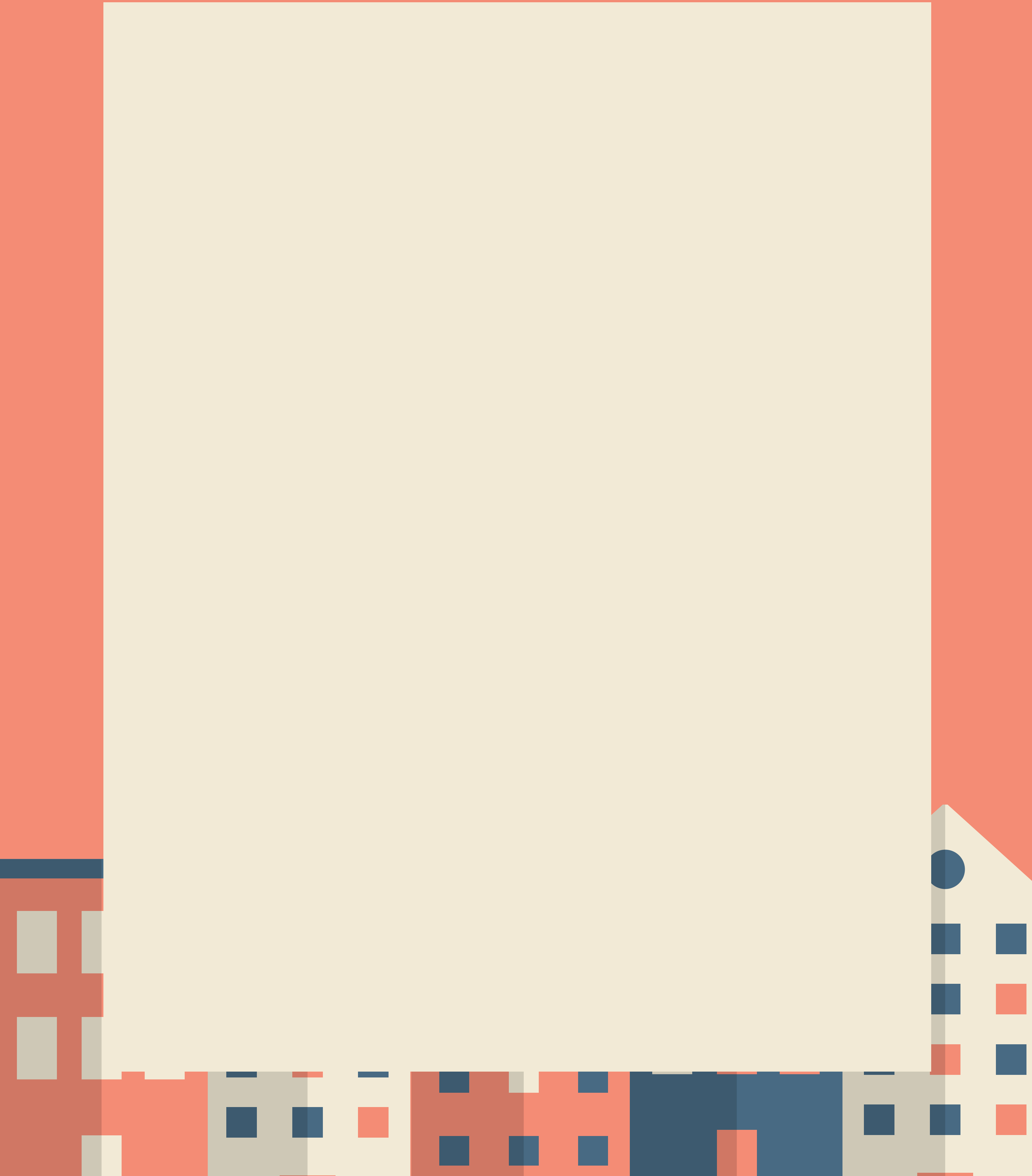
- When was it built?/When did it open?
